THE DEEP END (Inspiration: Jane Mellett)

Today we hear a very famous Gospel passage which we might dismiss easily because we feel we know it so well. **Love God, Love your neighbour** – it sounds so simple yet these are the toughest, most radical lines in the Gospel.

It sounds like two commandments and yet they are one, interconnected and inseparable, for to love God we must love our neighbour—especially those that society wants to dismiss: the migrant, the homeless family, the addict, the prisoner..... And by loving our neighbour and the earth that sustains our neighbour as well as ourselves, we are loving God. Today let us ask ourselves how we can live more fully this great commandment and be a shining example of Christ's love in the world.
