

Volunteers are required to answer the door, welcome clients and direct them to counselling rooms. They are also required to answer the phone.



You are invited to Saint Patrick's Cathedral Annual Remembrance Concert Friday 10th November 6.15pm,


during which the Cathedral Choir will sing Fauré's much loved Requiem. Admission is free, and there is retiring collection after the performance in aid of the Irish Red Cross.
