REFRAIN


.And through this shared Eucharist we are the living Church.

His living body active in our world. REFRAIN


Entrance Hymn June 21st


Longing for light, we wait in darkness. Longing for truth, we turn to you. Make us your own, your holy people, Light for the world to see.
