The death has occurred of Very Rev. Walter Canon Harris P.E.

Canon Harris has lived among us for the past thirty-six years. Parish Priest-1989-2003, Pastor Emeritus for the last twenty-two years. A dedicated priest, totally

> committed to church and parish. He saw many changes during his pastorate and introduced several initiatives to promote faith, heritage and to foster a sense of community in St Brigid's Parish.

> He began the first Parish Day to mark Jubilee Year 2000 -a day of celebration which continues to the present. He funded a group of young people to travel to Paris for World Youth Day

and encouraged the active participation of lay people in parish life. Born in Dublin Canon Harris was a Tipperary man at heart. A dedicated follower of the Tipp teams – always asking the prayers of the congregation for Tipp in Croke Park! He continued to help in the church, visit the sick in their homes and in hospital right up to Covid.

His parishioners loved and appreciated his goodness and kindness and had the privilege of joining him in St Brigid's to celebrate his seventieth anniversary of his priesthood on 15 June 2023.

May he now receive the reward of a long life lived in the service of those in the parishes he served and the people whose lives he touched. May he rest in peace.

Our Annual St Brigid's Parish Family Day will take place after mass on Sunday 25th May. The Parish Team extend a special invitation to the children who received the sacraments in recent weeks—they might like to wear their special outfits! 
