Parish Assembly—Update

The Parish Pastoral Council would like to thank everyone who took part in the Parish Assembly.

Talking to people, it seems to have been a very positive experience and certainly generated plenty of feedback. It will take us a while to sort through this feedback so it will be into the New Year before we can publish it.

In the meantime, however, we have started to take some actions:

- I. The sound system: An acoustics engineer has surveyed the church and is drawing up recommendations for the necessary changes.
- 2. Improvements to the Newsletter: A larger format missalette has been sourced to give more space for information.
- 3. Funeral Ministry Team: Two meetings have taken place for interested volunteers.

 Training will be provided in the New Year.
- 4. **Provide more family & child centred liturgies:** The vigil mass on Christmas Eve will be aimed at families with young children. It will be held earlier in the evening; 6 pm rather than 7 pm.
