The Deep End 'It may bear fruit next year'

Today's Gospel brings a thorny question for Jesus as the people ask why a number of Galileans were killed by the Romans as they made sacrifices to God. Were they worse offenders than others in Jerusalem? No. The basic question is why do bad things happen to certain people? Jesus' response to the difficult question on suffering is to focus on the living.
