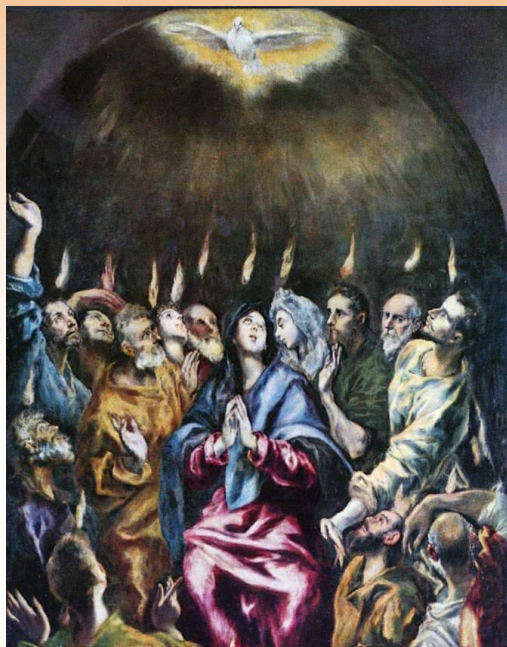


St. Brigid's Parish, Blanchardstown Newsletter
