A few simple ideas for Holy Week





Sacred Space – Set up a small dedicated space somewhere in your home. You can add items that bring meaning to Holy Week e.g. some greenery for Palm Sunday, a prayer that you like, a small cross (you can make one if you don't have one), a candle. You will think of your own ideas, which make your sacred space special for you.

Holy Thursday — As you eat your meal in the evening try to be aware of Jesus eating with his disciples on this night.

Wash your hands in a bowl at the table before eating as a sign of the washing of the feet.

Say grace before meals thanking God for the Food on our table and thanking God for our parish community, the body of Christ.

recipes on the Internet. Say a prayer giving thanks before eating them.
