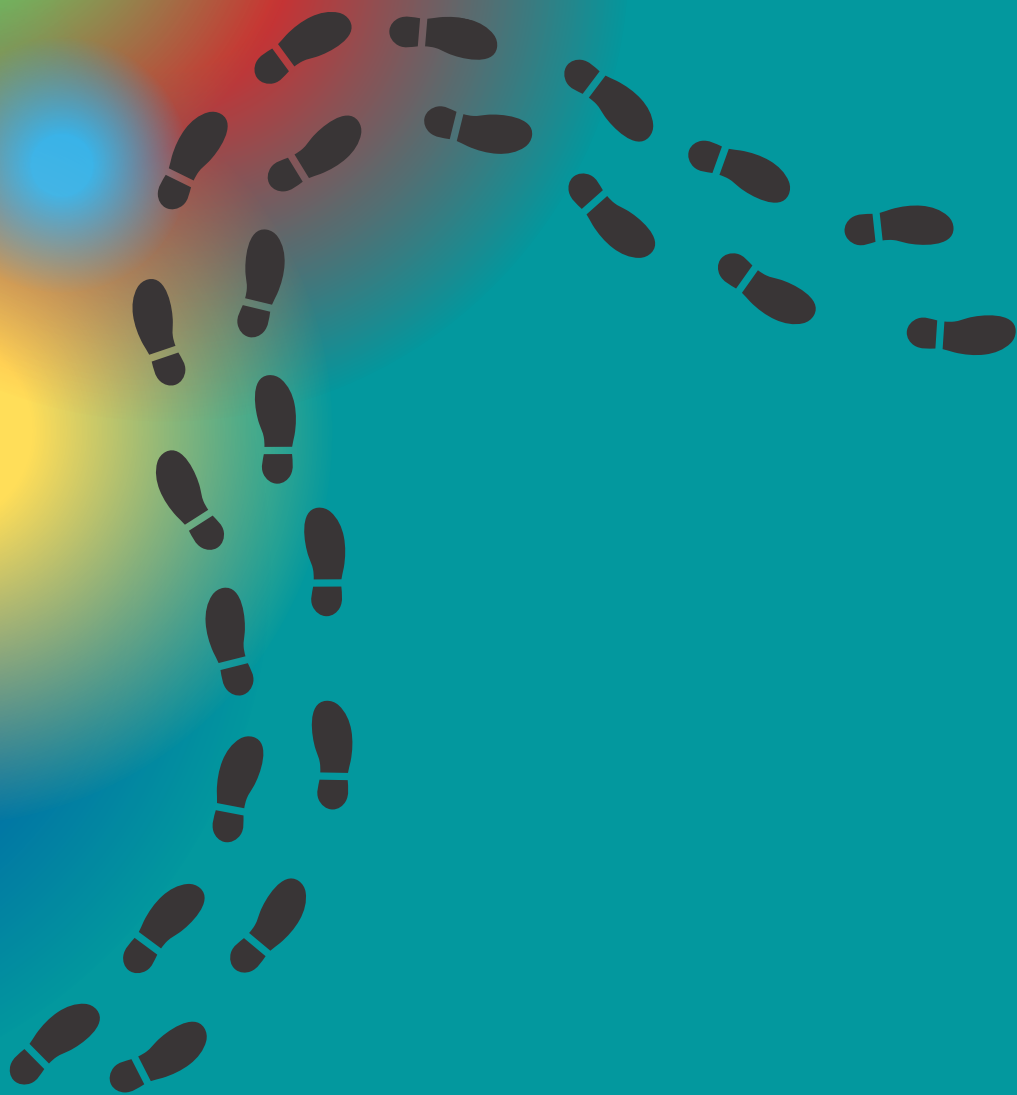

Bringing Good News

WHEN YOU ARE CONFIRMED YOU ARE CALLED LIKE JESUS TO BE A PERSON WHO SHARES THE GOOD NEWS.

God sent me to tell the prisoners of sin that they are free, and to tell the blind that they can see again. God sent me to free those who have been treated unfairly, and to announce the time when the Lord will show kindness to his people."

(Luke 4: 16-19)

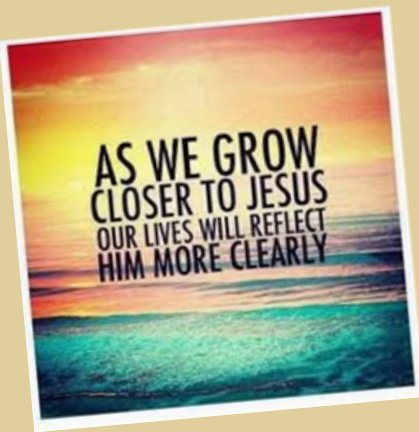

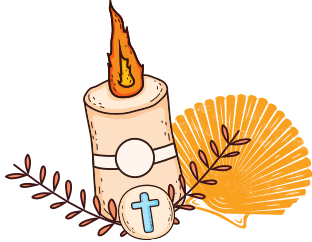

At Confirmation, the Celebrant will **anoint** you with the oil of **Chrism** for **service** and **witness**. You are already anointed.

This happened at your **Baptism**, where the priest anointed you to live like Jesus as a **priest**, **prophet** and **king**.

Just as a priest worships, you were called to **pray** and **worship**.

Just as a king serves, you were called to **serve** others in love.

Just as the prophets were called to speak up for the truth, you too at your Baptism were called to **stand up** for God.

Through the anointing of Confirmation, you will be given more **strength** to serve, set aside for service, **sealed** with the gifts of the Holy Spirit so that you can make a difference in the world.

You will be marked forever with this seal so that you can be a witness.

This seal is a promise that you will always belong to God.

This means that you must honour God's promise by being faithful.

The **thumb** is the closest finger to you so start praying for those who are closest to you. They are the people easiest to remember – your family and your friends.

The next finger is the **index finger**. It points the way. Pray for teachers and for all those who help you to learn.

The **middle finger** is the tallest. It reminds us of our leaders and all who have authority to change the world and make it a better place. They make important decisions that affect people's lives and need God's guidance.

The **fourth finger is the ring finger**. This is the weakest of all your fingers. It should remind you to pray for people who are weak, sick, poor, or facing other problems. They need your prayers.

Finally, your **little finger** should remind you to pray for yourself. When you have finished praying for others you will be able to see your own needs.

Called to be Saints

At Confirmation we are reminded that we are called to be Saints.

A Saint is someone who:

- Followed Jesus in everything they did
- Lived their baptism to the full
- Relied on the Holy Spirit to help them



Some saints are known for their great patience or courage. Other saints are known for standing up for what is right and sometimes dying for what they believe. Then there are saints who were great teachers and told people about the love of Jesus.

JOSEPHINE BAKHITA, BORN IN THE SUDAN. TAKEN CAPTIVE BY SLAVE TRADERS, AND ABUSED BY THEM. SHE BECAME CHRISTIAN AND THEN ENTERED A CONVENT IN ITALY. SHE ALWAYS FORGAVE THOSE WHO HAD ABUSED HER AND HURT HER. SHE TAUGHT EVERYONE ABOUT COMPASSION.

FRANCIS OF ASSISI another Italian! Son of a rich merchant, gave up everything to become poor. Preached the Gospel with his life. Invented the Christmas crib. Loved animals and all creation.

KATERI TEKAKAWITHA DAUGHTER OF A MOHAWK CHIEF. BAPTISED WHEN SHE WAS NINETEEN. HAD GREAT FAITH FRIENDSHIPS. REMEMBERED AS A GOOD FRIEND OF GOD AND BRINGING OTHERS TO GOD.

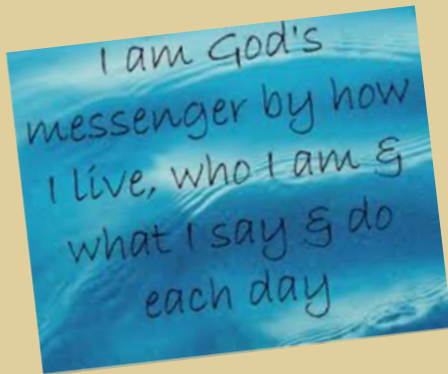

Rite 2:

Presentation of the Our Father



Presider: As Jesus taught his disciples to pray, the parents of these children have taught them to pray.

In this celebration today they will present them with the Lord's Prayer, a summary of how we should pray.

I now invite our candidates for Confirmation to come forward and stand, while we pray that each of them will be filled with a spirit of prayer.



*Each child is called forward by name
Candidates come forward and stand in front of the altar*

*The Presider lays hands on each candidate in turn
while the community prays in silence*

Presider: I invite our candidates to now stand around the altar to listen to the gospel reading where our Lord Jesus teaches his followers how to pray.

Candidates make their way to the altar and stand in a semi-circle to listen to the Gospel

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW

At that time Jesus said to his disciples:
'Say this when you pray:
Our Father who art in heaven
hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come;
thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread
and forgive us our trespasses

The children return to their seats and the presider explains the meaning and importance of the Lord's Prayer.

We pray that we may love one another as Jesus loves us and that we may always
have hearts that are ready to forgive.
LORD HEAR US

PARENT 5: And lead us not into temptation.
We pray that our hearts will always be set on God and that we will always turn to him
for help in times of temptation.
LORD HEAR US

We ask that these candidates whom we have presented with this prayer will love
and cherish it.
Through it may they come to know you as their loving Father and to worship you as

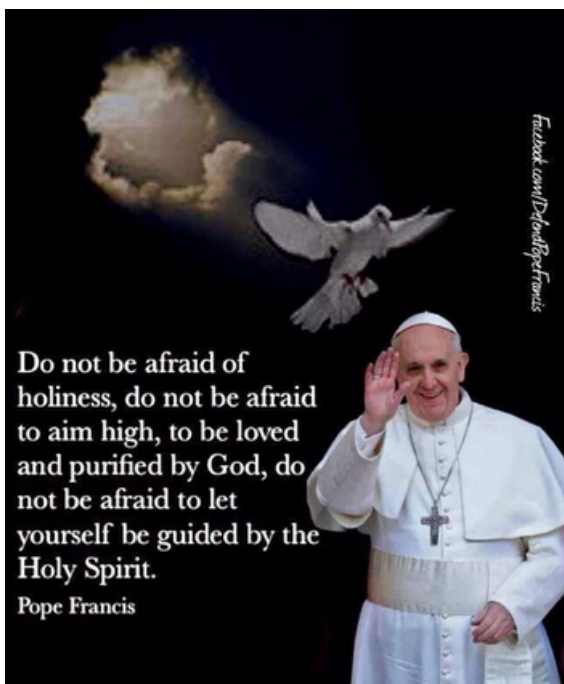

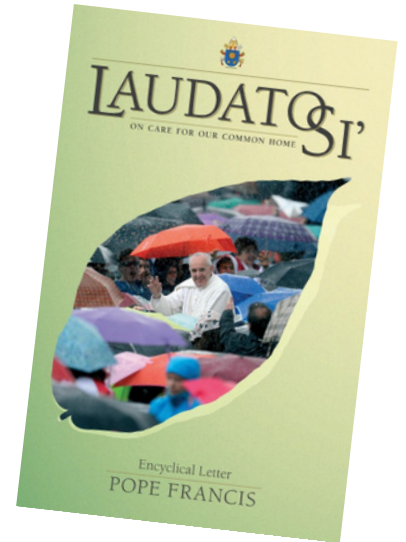

Session 8: Inspired by the Holy Spirit

On 24th May 2015, Pope Francis brought out an important letter for everybody in the world to read. It is called *Laudato Si'*. *Laudato Si'* means 'Praise be to you'. The name comes from the main phrase of St. Francis of Assisi's famous prayer, *Canticle of the Sun*. You learnt in Session 6 about St Francis and how he is the patron saint of animals and he was inspired by the Holy Spirit to care for all in creation. He inspires us today, too. Pope Francis says that this letter is about 'caring for our common home', the earth. We hear lots in our news and online about climate change, loss of bees and birds, rising water and loss of land.

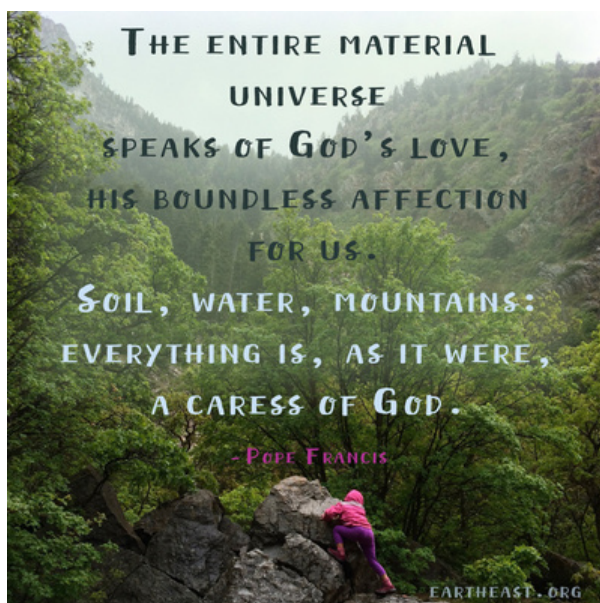

Session 9: A Spirit of Service

In the Sacrament of Confirmation the Holy Spirit will make you more like Jesus, bind you more closely to the family of the church and strengthen you for a life of service.

“

There are different kinds of gifts: but they are all from the same Spirit. There are different ways to serve; but all these ways are from the same Lord. And there are different ways that God works in people; out all these ways are from the same God. God works in us all in everything we do. Something from the Spirit can be seen in each person, to help everyone.

The Spirit gives one person the ability to speak with wisdom. And the same Spirit gives another the ability to speak with knowledge. The same Spirit gives faith to one person. And that one Spirit gives another gifts of healing. The Spirit gives to another person the power to do miracles, to another the ability to prophesy. And he gives to another the ability to know the difference between good and evil spirits. The Spirit gives one person the ability to speak in different kinds of languages and to another the ability to interpret those languages. One Spirit, the same Spirit, does all these things. The Spirit decides what to give each person.

There are many people in our society today living out a life of service, inspired by the Holy Spirit, to help in all different areas of need in our society. One area where there are many people doing great work is that of homelessness. Over the last number of years, we have had high numbers of people experiencing homelessness and people of faith have been responding to God's call to help.

BR KEVIN CROWLEY

In 1969, Br Kevin Crowley, a Capuchin Friar, set up the Capuchin Day Centre. He set it up after he saw a man eating food out of the bins in the city centre. More than 900 meals are provided every day and 1,500 food parcels are handed out to those people most in need every Wednesday. The centre has grown over the years and now includes services like shower and medical facilities. Many people volunteer their time at the centre and the centre relies mostly on fundraising to keep the doors open.

SR STAN



Sr Stan Kennedy is a member of the Religious Sisters of Charity. In 1985 after moving to Dublin, she saw the needs for working with those who faced homelessness and as a result founded *Focus Point*, which is now known as *Focus Ireland*. *Focus Ireland* is the biggest national, voluntary organisation helping people to find, create and maintain a home. In 2001, Sr Stan established Young Social Innovators (YSI), a national showcase providing an opportunity for students to become involved in social issues.



FR PETER MCVERRY

Fr Peter McVerry, a Jesuit priest, has been working in inner-city Dublin since 1974. In 1979 he opened a hostel for homeless boys aged 12-16 but saw that when the boys reached 16 and needed to leave, they had few options and most ended up back living on the streets. This led him to set about providing services and accommodation for older youths. By the end of 1983 he had founded a charity to tackle homelessness. This charity, the Peter McVerry Trust, is one of the country's largest organisations. In 2020, the charity supported 7,800 individuals experiencing homelessness.

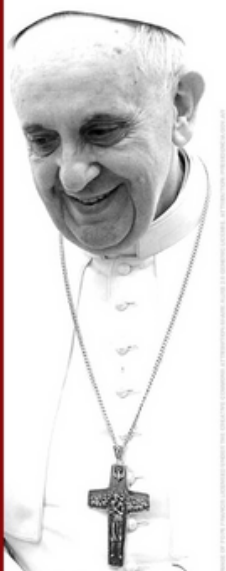

Confirmation Keywords

Advocate: an advocate is someone who helps and supports another person, particularly through difficult times

Anoint: to mark someone or something by making the Sign of the Cross with holy oil

Baptismal Promises: promises made for a child at Baptism and renewed at Confirmation, First Eucharist, and every year at Easter

Chrism: holy oil made of olive oil and balsam, blessed by the bishop on Holy Thursday and provides the strength to be a witness of God

Confer: to give

Confirmation: Confirmation is the final Sacrament in the Sacraments of Initiation, following on from Baptism and Eucharist. Confirmation is a person saying 'Yes' to their faith, taking ownership of their faith, and having the Holy Spirit activated in their lives as their advocate throughout life.

Confirmation Name: a name chosen that has significance for you (i.e. a saint or an important person in your life) and those characteristics of the person is what you want to follow in life

Disciple: a follower of Jesus

Dismissal: the part of the Mass/Liturgy where we are called to go forth to spread the Good News of the Gospel

Fruits of the Holy Spirit: characteristics that result from living by the gifts and power of the Holy Spirit: charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, chastity

Confirmation Keywords

Gifts of the Holy Spirit: seven gifts received in fullness in Confirmation: Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge, Right Judgement (Counsel), Reverence (Piety), Courage (Fortitude), and Wonder and Awe (Fear of the Lord)

Good News: the message of God's love; the message of the Gospel

Holy Spirit: the Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Holy Trinity – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – and is sent at Confirmation to be a helper and guide throughout life. The Holy Spirit is activated in each person and brings the Gifts and the Fruits

Initiation: to begin something. The Sacraments of Initiation helps bring a person into full membership of the church

Laying on of Hands: the raising of the bishop's/priest's hands in prayer over all to be confirmed

Pentecost: celebrated 50 days after Easter. Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and other followers of Jesus. It is often called the birthday of the church, and the first Confirmation

Sacrament: a Sacrament is an encounter where we meet Jesus in various ways e.g. in the Eucharist, in forgiveness at Reconciliation. There are 7 Sacraments in the church in 3 different categories.

- Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist
- Sacraments of Healing: Reconciliation and Sacrament of the Sick
- Sacraments of Vocation: Marriage and Holy Orders

Sponsor: someone who is an example of faith and will support and guide you on the journey of faith

Symbol: something that stands for something else

Witness: someone who sees or experiences an event and tells others about it
