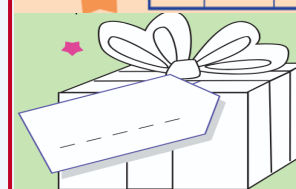
Children's Corner: In the Gospel Today

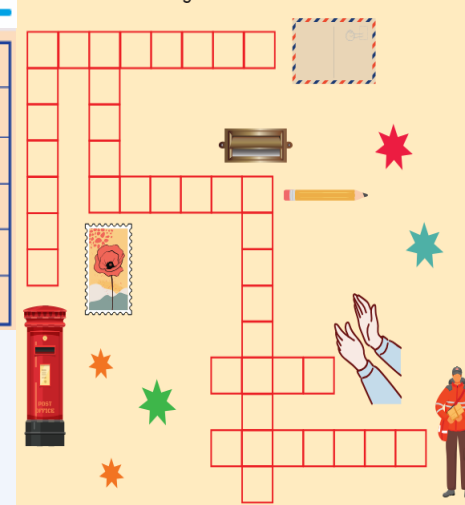

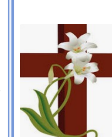
Confirmation Ceremony

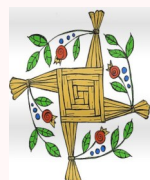
