Saints in the Church's calendar:

Tuesday 29th July—Ss Martha, Mary and Lazarus welcomed Jesus as a family friend. Martha generously offered him hospitality, Mary listened attentively to his words and Lazarus promptly emerged from the tomb at the command of the One who humiliated death.

Thursday 31st July— St Ignatius of Loyola 1491-1556, from the north of Spain, founded the society of Jesus. The experience of his conversion led to his writing of the Spiritual Exercises.

Friday 1st August—St Alphonsus Liguori 1696-1787. Founder of the Redemptorist Congregation, taught much on moral theology and the spiritual life.

Saturday 2nd August is the first Saturday of the month so mass will be at 10am with confessions immediately afterwards.

Monday 4th August is a Bank Holiday. Mass will be at 11am with no evening mass.

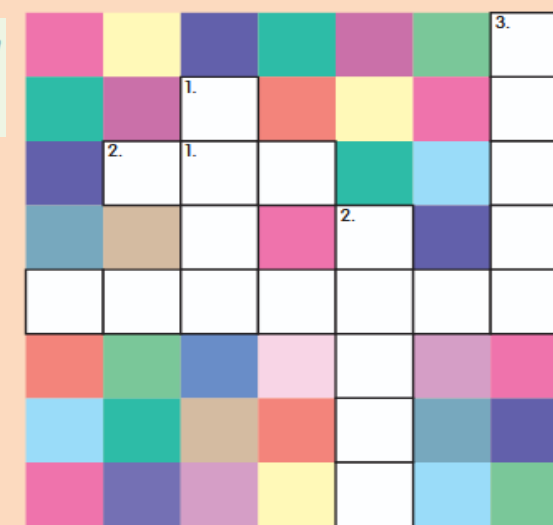
