We continue to receive regular news from Lira Perrier and 'Le Centre D'appui de L'enfant pour une Haïti Meilleure' (Child Support Centre for a Better Haiti). The children have returned to school now and this includes the new class of 39 students who will take the 9th Grade this year. This is similar to our Junior Certificate.

The investment in schoolbooks, food subsistence and teacher education, which our Parish has funded, has provided vital momentum for this initiative. The school still needs funds to extend their classrooms, and

further teacher education is still a challenge but still there is plenty of optimism for the year ahead.

Here in St. Brigid's, we have the opportunity to continue helping and we hope to organise a further collection in the approach to Christmas to provide additional support for the efforts of Lira and his companions in this great endeavour.

(followed by confessions)




Children's Corner:
