We invite you to join us on our annual summer Heritage Pilgrimage.



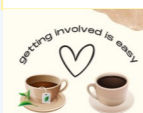

Please use the envelope provided, giving your details, so that the parish can help process the tax rebate from Revenue. The parish can reclaim the tax no matter whether you are PAYE or Self-Assessed. This tax rebate from Revenue is now an important source of income for the parish.
