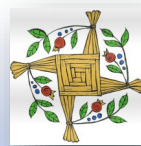

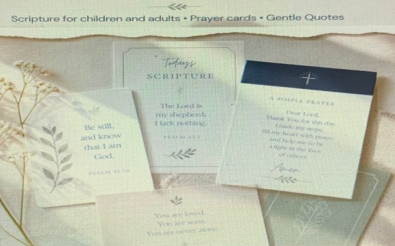

PATHWAYS INTO PASTORAL MINISTRY

This course is for any adult who
wants to explore and grow their
faith. Over a year, participants
are offered inputs on foundation-
al issues of faith and the impact
they have on ministry and parish
life. There is also time for small
group sharing and the opportuni-
ty for three different retreat ex-
periences. On completion of the
course, people are presented
with a certificate.

Pathways is run on a Thursday
evening (during term times) at
the St Patrick's campus of DCU in
Drumcondra from 7.15pm to
9.15pm. The course starts on
September 24 and runs until May
13, and costs €300. Online regis-

land on good soil, grows healthy roots and produces excellent grain!

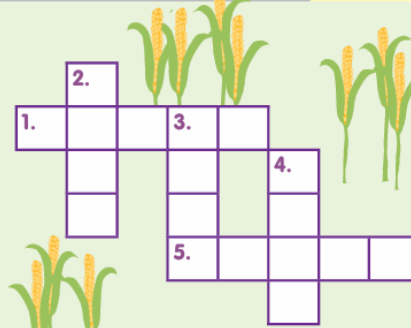
Seed search
